Re-tooling Residencies is a 2 year project devoted to developing cooperation between Eastern and Western EU art institutions by sharing knowledge and supporting professional training for cultural managers. This project will provide theoretical and practical knowledge through a study and research programme preceded by an International Conference on Artistic Residencies on November 16-19th 2009. Six individuals will be selected from an open call to an exchange programme for emerging professionals who want to start a new residency programme in a South Eastern European countries*. In the 18 months following the conference, the 6 chosen professionals will visit established programmes (i.e. partner organizations) to become familiar with different methods of organizing artistic residencies, participate in the administration of projects, meet artists and professionals. Versatile in form, the visits will combine elements of study visit, research and internship in art coordination. Each participant will take part in two one-month long internships as well as in the conference. Places of internships will be chosen together with the organizers. All the costs (per-diems, flight, accommodation) will be covered by the organizers.

If you are interested in participation, please send up to one page (1800 characters) description of the residency which you would like to establish, with a specification what type of residency programme you are interested in, why is this particular type suitable to the place of its destination, and what possible sources for financing can you see for the residency in the future in your country.
